

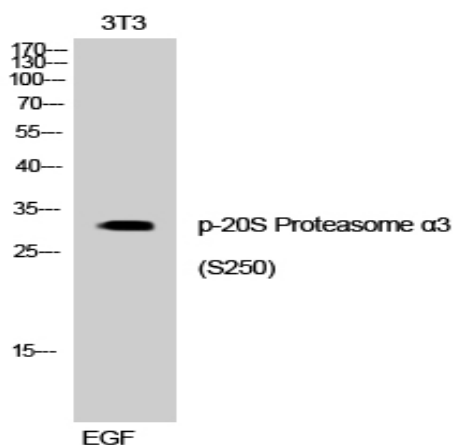

Specificity :	Phospho-20S Proteasome α 3 (S250) Polyclonal Antibody detects endogenous levels of 20S Proteasome α 3 protein only when phosphorylated at S250.

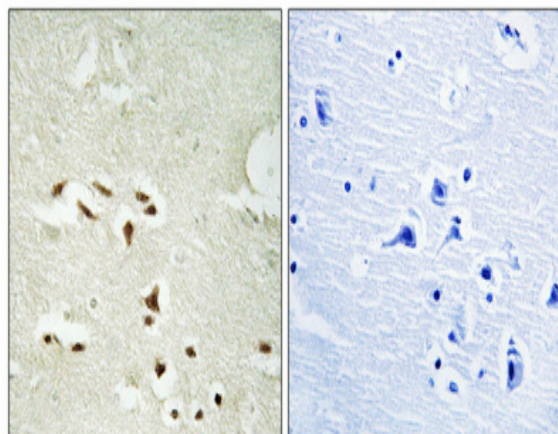

Background :	<u>The proteasome is a multicatalytic proteinase complex with a highly ordered ring-shaped 20S core structure. The core structure is composed of 4 rings of 28 non-identical subunits; 2 rings are composed of 7 alpha subunits and 2 rings are composed of 7 beta subunits. Proteasomes are distributed throughout eukaryotic cells at a high concentration and cleave peptides in an ATP/ubiquitin-dependent process in a non-lysosomal pathway. An essential function of a modified proteasome, the immunoproteasome, is the processing of class I MHC peptides. This gene encodes a member of the peptidase T1A family, that is a 20S core alpha subunit. Two alternative transcripts encoding different isoforms have been identified. Function :	<u>catalytic activity: Cleavage of peptide bonds with very broad specificity., function: The proteasome is a multicatalytic proteinase complex which is characterized by its ability to cleave peptides with Arg, Phe, Tyr, Leu, and Glu adjacent to the leaving group at neutral or slightly basic pH. The proteasome has an ATP-dependent proteolytic activity., similarity: Belongs to the peptidase T1A family., subunit: The 26S proteasome consists of a 20S proteasome core and two 19S regulatory subunits. The 20S proteasome core is composed of 28 subunits that are arranged in four stacked rings, resulting in a barrel-shaped structure. The two end rings are each formed by seven alpha subunits, and the two central rings are each formed by seven beta subunits., subunit: The 26S proteasome consists of a 20S proteasome core and two 19S regulatory subunits. 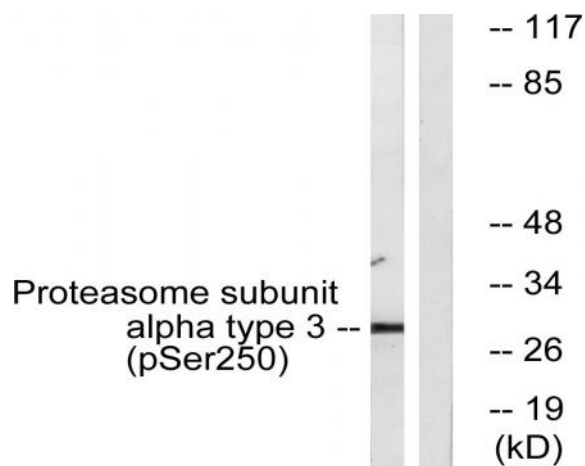

Western Blot analysis of 3T3 cells using Phospho-20S Proteasome α 3 (S250) Polyclonal Antibody



Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded Human brain. Antibody was diluted at 1:100(4° overnight). High-pressure and temperature Tris-EDTA,pH8.0 was used for antigen retrieval. Negative control (right) obtained from antibody was pre-absorbed by immunogen peptide.



Western blot analysis of lysates from NIH/3T3 cells treated with EGF 200ng/ml 30', using Proteasome alpha3 (Phospho-Ser250) Antibody. The lane on the right is blocked with the phospho peptide.
