<b>Background :</b>	domain:Contains 2 copies of a cytoplasmic motif that is referred to as the

immunoreceptor tyrosine-based inhibitor motif (ITIM). This motif is involved in modulation of cellular responses. The phosphorylated ITIM motif can bind the SH2 domain of several SH2-containing phosphatases. Putative adhesion molecule of myelomonocytic-derived cells that mediates sialic-acid dependent binding to cells. Preferentially binds to alpha-2,6-linked sialic acid. The sialic acid recognition site may be masked by cis interactions with sialic acids on the same cell surface. In the immune response, may act as an inhibitory receptor upon ligand induced tyrosine phosphorylation by recruiting cytoplasmic phosphatase(s) via their SH2 domain(s) that block signal transduction through dephosphorylation of signaling molecules. Induces apoptosis in acute myeloid leukemia (in vitro). online information: Siglec-3, PTM: Phosphorylation of Tyr-340 is involved in binding to PTPN6 and PTPN11. Phosphorylation of Tyr-358 is involved in binding to PTPN6. similarity: Belongs to the immunoglobulin superfamily. SIGLEC (sialic acid binding Ig-like lectin) family. similarity: Contains 1 Ig-like C2-type (immunoglobulin-like) domain. similarity: Contains 1 Ig-like V-type (immunoglobulin-like) domain. subunit: Interacts with PTPN6/SHP-1 and PTPN11/SHP-2 upon phosphorylation. tissue specificity: Monocytic/myeloid lineage cells.
