Isoform 2 may function as an endogenous inhibitory regulator of HSC70 by competing the co-chaperones.,induction:Constitutively synthesized.,PTM:Phosphorylated upon DNA damage, probably by ATM or ATR.,similarity:Belongs to the heat shock protein 70 family.,subcellular location:Translocates rapidly from the cytoplasm to the nuclei, and especially to the nucleoli, upon heat shock. Identified by mass spectrometry in melanosome fractions from stage I to stage IV.,subunit:Interacts with HSPH1/HSP105. Interacts with IRAK1BP1 (By similarity). Interacts with PACRG and TSC2. Interacts with SV40 VP1.,tissue specificity:Ubiquitous.,</p> <p>protein folding, 'de novo' protein folding, post-Golgi vesicle-mediated</p>

<b>Function :</b>	transport, response to unfolded protein, response to organic substance, membrane organization, vesicle-mediated transport, intracellular transport, Golgi vesicle transport, 'de novo' posttranslational protein folding, chaperone mediated protein folding requiring cofactor, regulation of cell cycle, response to protein stimulus,
<b>Subcellular Location :</b>	Cytoplasm. Melanosome. Nucleus, nucleolus. Cell membrane. Localized in cytoplasmic mRNP granules containing untranslated mRNAs. Translocates rapidly from the cytoplasm to the nuclei, and especially to the nucleoli, upon heat shock.
