<b>Sequence :</b>	A DNA sequence encoding the human FGFR1 (Met1-Glu285) was fused with the C-terminal His Tag

<b>Formulation :</b>	Supplied as solution form in PBS pH 7.5./ Lyophilized from PBS pH 7.5.
<b>Source :</b>	Mammalian cells
<b>Dilution :</b>	Reconstitute in sterile water for a stock solution
<b>Concentration :</b>	>90% as determined by SDS-PAGE
<b>Storage Stability :</b>	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze thaw cycles. Store at 2 to 8 °C for one week . Store at -20 to -80 °C for twelve months from the date of receipt.
<b>Subcellular Location :</b>	Cell membrane; Single-pass type I membrane protein. Nucleus. Cytoplasm, cytosol. Cytoplasmic vesicle. After ligand binding, both receptor and ligand are rapidly internalized. Can translocate to the nucleus after internalization, or by translocation from the endoplasmic reticulum or Golgi apparatus to the cytosol, and from there to the nucleus.
<b>Expression :</b>	Detected in astrocytoma, neuroblastoma and adrenal cortex cell lines. Some isoforms are detected in foreskin fibroblast cell lines, however isoform 17, isoform 18 and isoform 19 are not detected in these cells.
