Background :	CD27 molecule(CD27) Homo sapiens The protein encoded byThis gene is a member of the TNF-receptor superfamily.This receptor is required for generation and long-term maintenance of T cell immunity. It binds to ligand CD70, and plays a key role in regulating B-cell activation and immunoglobulin synthesis.This

receptor transduces signals that lead to the activation of NF-kappaB and MAPK8/JNK. Adaptor proteins TRAF2 and TRAF5 have been shown to mediate the signaling process of This receptor. CD27-binding protein (SIVA), a proapoptotic protein, can bind to This receptor and is thought to play an important role in the apoptosis induced by This receptor. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008]

Function : Receptor for CD70/CD27L. May play a role in survival of activated T-cells. May play a role in apoptosis through association with SIVA1.

Subcellular Location : Membrane; Single-pass type I membrane protein.
