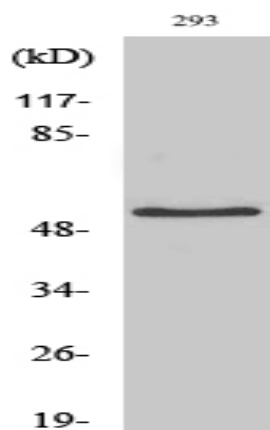

**Function :** similarity:Belongs to the TALE/IRO homeobox family.,similarity:Contains 1 homeobox DNA-binding domain.,

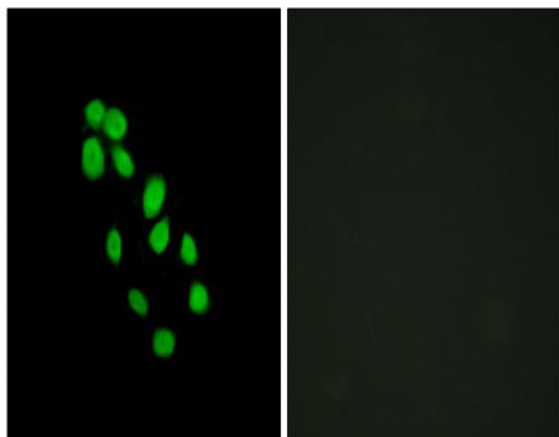
**Subcellular Location :** Nucleus .

**Expression :** Kidney,Lung,

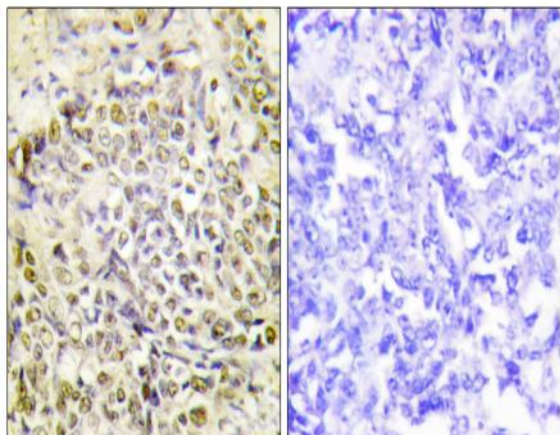

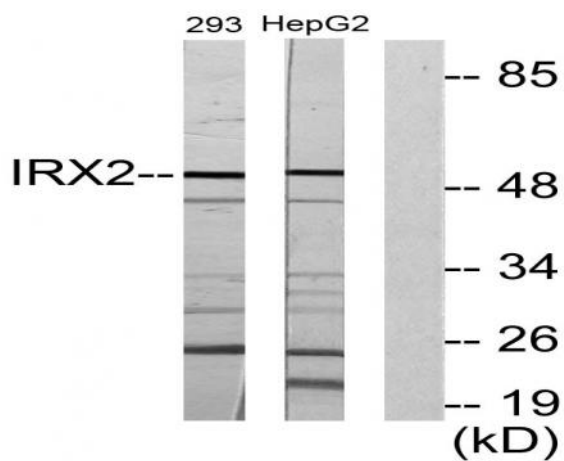

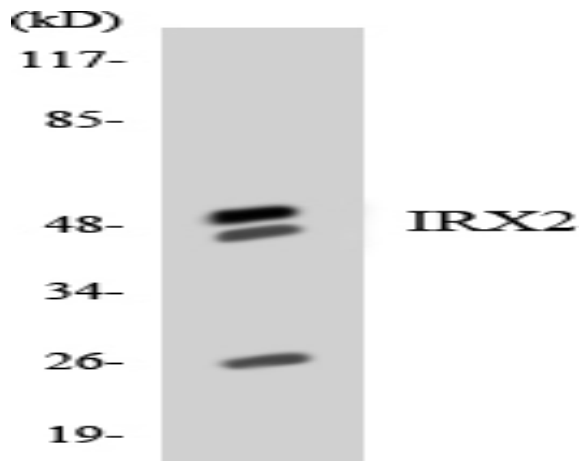
Immunofluorescence analysis of HepG2 cells, using IRX2 Antibody. The picture on the right is blocked with the synthesized peptide.
