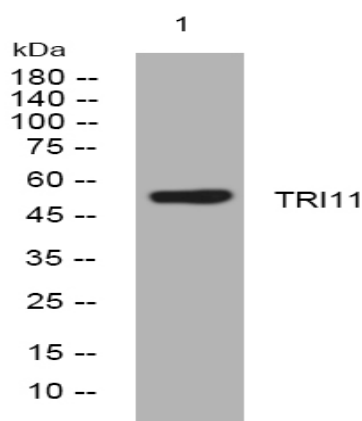
Background : The protein encoded by this gene is a member of the tripartite motif (TRIM) family. The TRIM motif includes three zinc-binding domains, a RING, a B-box type 1 and a B-box type 2, and a coiled-coil region. This protein localizes to the nucleus and the cytoplasm. Its function has not been identified. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008],

Function : domain: The coiled-coil domain and the B30.2 domain are both necessary for interaction with humanin., function: May have E3 ubiquitin ligase activity. May contribute to the regulation of the intracellular level of humanin or humanin-containing proteins through the proteasomal degradation pathway., similarity: Belongs to the TRIM/RBCC family., similarity: Contains 1 B box-type zinc finger., similarity: Contains 1 B30.2/SPRY domain., similarity: Contains 1 RING-type zinc finger., subunit: Binds cytoplasmic tail of integrin alpha-1. Interacts with the humanin peptide., tissue specificity: Ubiquitous.,

Subcellular Location : Cytoplasm. Nucleus.

Expression : Ubiquitous.
