Background: The protein encoded by this gene is a cell surface glycoprotein involved in

leukocyte migration, T-cell adhesion, ganglioside GM1 and transmembrane protein transport, and T-cell death by a caspase-independent pathway. In



addition, the encoded protein may have the ability to rearrange the actin cytoskeleton and may also act as an oncosuppressor in osteosarcoma. This gene is found in the pseudoautosomal region of chromosomes X and Y and escapes X-chromosome inactivation. There is a related pseudogene located immediately adjacent to this locus. Function:

function:Involved in T-cell adhesion processes. It is involved in spontaneous rosette formation with erythrocytes.,miscellaneous:The gene encoding for this protein is located in the pseudoautosomal region 1 (PAR1) of X and Y chromosomes.,PTM:Extensively O-glycosylated.,similarity:Belongs to the CD99 family.,




