Background : activating transcription factor 4(ATF4) Homo sapiens This gene encodes a transcription factor that was originally identified as a widely expressed mammalian DNA binding protein that could bind a tax-responsive enhancer element in the LTR of HTLV-1. The encoded protein was also isolated and characterized as the cAMP-response element binding protein 2 (CREB-2). The protein encoded by this gene belongs to a family of DNA-binding proteins that includes the AP-1 family of transcription factors, cAMP-response element binding proteins (CREBs) and CREB-like proteins. These transcription factors share a leucine zipper region that is involved in protein-protein interactions, located C-terminal to a stretch of basic amino acids that functions as a DNA binding domain. Two alternative transcripts encoding the same protein have been described. Two pseudogenes are located on the X chromosome at q28 in a region containing a large inverted duplication. [provid

Function : function:Transcriptional activator. Binds the cAMP response element (CRE) (consensus: 5'-GTGACGT[AC][AG]-3'), a sequence present in many viral and cellular promoters. It binds to a Tax-responsive enhancer element in the long terminal repeat of HTLV-I.,similarity:Belongs to the bZIP family.,similarity:Contains 1 bZIP domain.,subcellular location:Colocalizes with GABBR1 in hippocampal neuron dendritic membranes.,subunit:Interacts with the C-terminal region of GABBR1 via the leucine zipper of its C-terminal bZIP domain. Interacts with the C-terminal region of GABBR2 (By similarity). Binds DNA as a homo-or heterodimer. Interacts with the N-terminal region of CEP290.,

Subcellular Location : Nucleus . Nucleus speckle . Cytoplasm . Cell membrane . Cytoplasm, cytoskeleton, microtubule organizing center, centrosome . Colocalizes with GABBR1 in hippocampal neuron dendritic membranes (By similarity). Colocalizes with NEK6 at the centrosome (PubMed:20873783). Recruited to nuclear speckles following interaction with EP300/p300 (PubMed:16219772). .
