**Background:** CD185, also known as CXCR5, is a 42 kD G-protein coupled receptor with

> seven transmembrane regions. CXCR5 is expressed by mature B cells, follicular helper T cells, Burkitt's lymphoma cells and a subset of neurons, and mediates



cell migration to the B cell follicles in the secondary lymphoid organs. The ligand of CXCR5 is CXCL13 (BLC).

**Function:** Cytokine receptor that binds to B-lymphocyte chemoattractant (BLC). Involved in

B-cell migration into B-cell follicles of spleen and Peyer patches but not into those of mesenteric or peripheral lymph nodes. May have a regulatory function in Burkitt

lymphoma (BL) lymphomagenesis and/or B-cell differentiation.

Subcellular Location :

Cell membrane; Multi-pass membrane protein.

**Expression:** Expression in mature B-cells and Burkitt lymphoma cells.
